The Truth and Reconciliation Scholarship honors the children who never returned home and survivors of residential schools, as well as their families and communities. The National Day for Truth and Reconciliation on September 30th commemorates the impacts of residential schools and to promote the concept of “Every Child Matters”.

Scholarship of \$1,200.00 is available to members in good standing or children/legal wards of members in good standing who are continuing their education beyond high school.

Those eligible are members who have been in good standing for 12 consecutive months and/or children or legal wards of a member who has been in good standing for more than 12 consecutive months on August 1st of the year for which the application is made.

The Scholarship is for attendance in a minimum two-year program at any university, community college or recognized school of nursing and applicants must show proof of enrolment.

The award shall be made in two installments of \$600.00 each; one installment upon enrolment and one at mid-term upon receipt of transcript of marks. Winner and alternates will be selected by a random draw. The successful applicant, alternate and unsuccessful applicants will be notified immediately following the drawing of the award.

All enquiries regarding the scholarship should be directed to your Local Officers, Sub-Local Officers or Stewards. Qualified applicants may re-apply annually.
